

Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - Overview of CEFR Scales

Proficient User

- C2 Can understand with ease virtually everything heard or read. Can summarise information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments and accounts in a coherent presentation. Can express him/herself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer shades of meaning even in more complex situations.
- C1 Can understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts, and recognise implicit meaning. Can express him/herself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. Can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic and professional purposes. Can produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organisational patterns, connectors and cohesive devices.

Independent User

- B2 Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialisation. Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either person. Can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.
- B1 Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc. Can deal with most situations likely to arise whilst travelling in an area where the language is spoken. Can produce simple connected text on topics, which are familiar, or of personal interest. Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes & ambitions and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.

Basic User

- A2 Can understand sentences and frequent expressions about everyday topics (e.g. basic personal and family information, shopping, local places & work). Can communicate in routine tasks that require a simple exchange of information. Can describe in a simple way his/her background and lifestyle, and immediate environment, as well as talk about the past and future in a basic way.
- A1 Can understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases. Can ask and answer basic questions about personal details (for example, his/her city or town, his/her house, family and friends, and possessions). Can interact in a simple way if the other person talks slowly, clearly and gives help.
